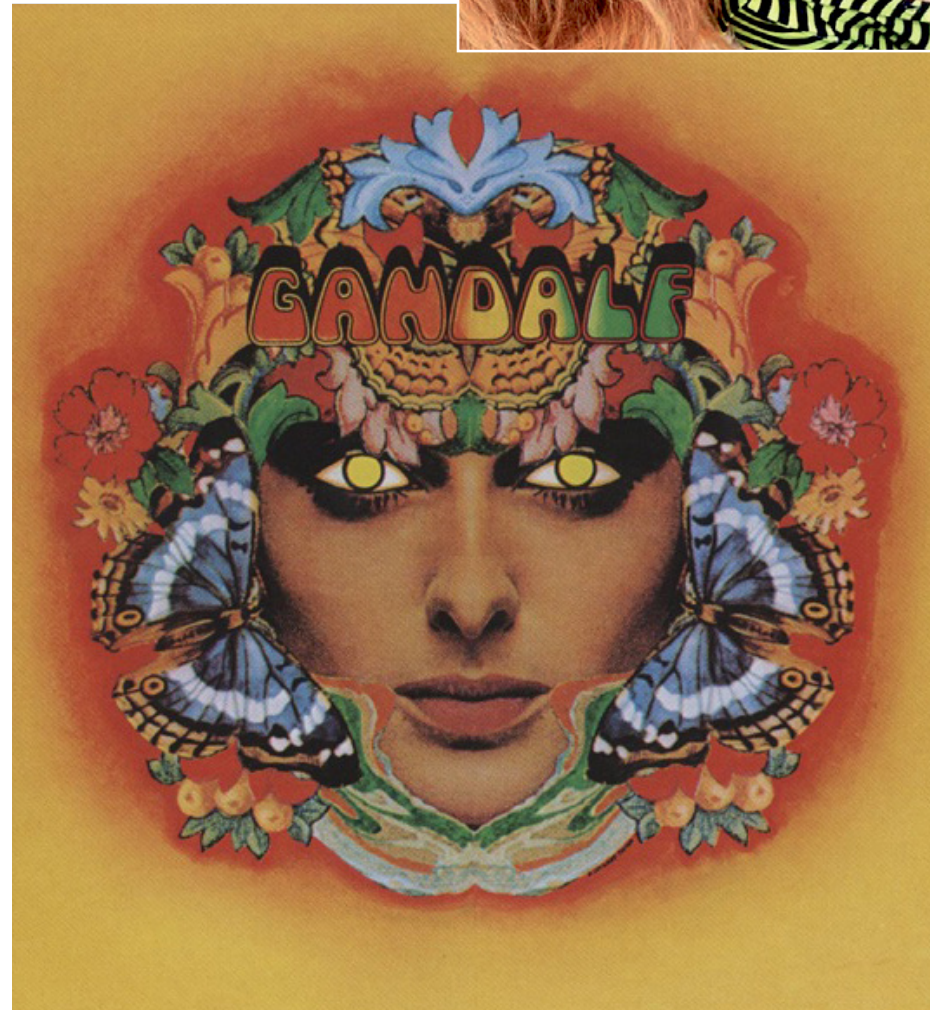

They released one studio album in 1969. This album is a collection of mostly cover songs that have been covered in a whimsical and magical fashion.

The dreaminess of Peter Sando’s vocals complements perfectly the ethereal use of the synthesizers, sprinkled with the perfect amount and types of delay through the album. It has a dreamy feel like the tracks were just plucked from the ether.

Three of the tracks are covers of Tim Hardin tracks yet somehow Gandalf managed to make these completely unique and the entire album sound flawlessly as their own style. Tickets are on sale now for [Modernism Week](#), the annual festival highlighting mid-century modern architecture, art, interior and landscape design, and vintage culture in the greater Palm Springs area. The fall event takes place from Thursday, October 24 through Sunday, October 27.

While smaller in scope than the 11-day festival held every year in February, the October event will offer more than 50 events over four days, including many free and low-cost programs.

New events this year include:

BEST FRIENDS ANIMAL SANCTUARY CELEBRATES 40 YEARS OF SAVING COMPANION CREATURES

On any given day, [Best Friends Animal Sanctuary](#) in Kanab, Utah is the healing home for up to 1,600 dogs, cats, birds, bunnies, horses, pigs, parrots and other animals. The largest sanctuary of its kind in the U.S., Best Friends has become the heart of a collaborative no-kill movement.

Since it opened on the site of the old Kanab Movie Ranch, the sanctuary has expanded to 3,700 acres of rolling hills where dinosaurs once roamed, and recently opened the [Best Friends Roadhouse and Mercantile](#) in town. It offers 40 rooms and suites where pets are not just welcome, but encouraged. No pets? No problem. With enough advance notice, you can give a local homeless dog or cat a night of company by hosting a sleepover at the roadhouse with a pet from Best Friends Animal Sanctuary. All the people food on the property is vegan, and a stay includes two free all-you-can-eat vegan lunch buffet tickets for the property's Angel Village Café.

Best Friends has left a growing paw print that includes 400 employees in [Kanab](#) and 6,000 volunteers who either live in town or volunteer while visiting and have outposts around the country including Texas, New York, Utah, and California.

cifically trained and tasked with facilitating adoptions, and marketing animals in need to network them to potential homes.

California ranks second in shelter deaths in the country with more than 66,000 dogs and cats dying in shelters. In 2023, the state saw a dramatic uptick of 46%, or 22,000, dogs being killed. Cat life saving also saw a decrease last year, with upwards of 40,900 felines losing their lives because they found themselves temporarily homeless.

Nationally, 2.3 million dogs and cats were adopted in 2023, 345,000 fewer adoptions than in 2019, with a net result of 415,000 adoptable dogs and cats being killed in shelters last year. Best Friends data shows that pet adoption has been steadily declining over the last five years, with more people getting pets from breeders and pet stores. Simultaneously, shelter intakes have increased, leading to 415,000 adoptable dogs and cats being destroyed in shelters last year.

The sustainable home base in Utah, which is run entirely on donations, is a textbook example of how the no-kill concept thrives. Horse and bunny poop are recycled and clippings from the cafe are composted. Water comes from the river that runs through it and natural springs. They have their own water truck and cutter truck onsite to keep lightning strikes contained as well as their own mechanics shop. A full-time staff of veterinarians is on site.

The horses end up at the sanctuary mostly due to neglect and abandonment or have been taken away from people through court cases. They have a covered equestrian center with fans and sprinklers to keep the dust down and have training sessions with them - how to ride with a saddle and get in and out of horse trailers. They have

"For the past 40 years, Best Friends Animal Society has been working toward their vision of a country where pets aren't killed just because they don't have a place to call home," Brittany Thorn, Executive Director, [Best Friends Animal Society Los Angeles](#) tells L.A. Weekly. "L.A. has always been an area close to the organization's heart. That's why to save even more dog and cat Angelenos, we opened the Best Friends Pet Adoption Center in West LA nearly eleven years ago. By having a home base here, we can positively impact our city's dogs and cats to help make L.A. a no-kill city and save even more lives."

While L.A.'s housing crisis has helped fuel overcrowded animal shelters, Best Friends has a goal of taking the entire country to no-kill in 2025.

According to the animal welfare organization, to create a no-kill community, shelters in the Greater Los Angeles area need to implement practical solutions to increase lifesaving like creating robust foster programs, designating staff to be spe-

burros, miniature horses, and mules that have been retired from the Grand Canyon. Some horses are rideable and others aren't, the pasture pals. There's a blind pasture for those with vision problems.

There's the Cat World facility (because cats rule the world) and Dog Town. Every building in cats is for specific needs like those that have come from feral colonies, and are promptly spayed and neutered. Not the ones to come inside and snuggle, these cats are used for pest control. There are separate buildings for the snufflers. These felines are all available for adoption or just to pet and visit daily, especially during Black Cat Month. There's a feline leukemia-positive building and cat walking paths. There are about 700 cats at a time

at cat headquarters and about 400 dogs at a time in Dog Town. Fleas? No problem, the top of the sanctuary is at an elevation where they don't exist.

After football player Michael Vick was convicted of running an illegal dog fighting ring in the Bad Newz dog fighting investigation, Best Friends took 22 of the most difficult cases, mainly pit bull terriers. Many of them were rehabilitated and adopted. There were two dogs that by court order could not be adopted because of their street value - the grand champion and breeder of grand champions. The judge feared they'd be stolen and sent back into the ring. The dogs were housed in a separate facility, protected by special security to ensure their safety and

rehabilitation.

Those dogs have since passed on and have been buried in the sanctuary's massive Angel's Outlook memorial garden. The structure currently houses dogs with behavioral issues, where trainers spend a lot of time. There are also single-dog areas for those who can't be around others and are at the most risk of not being adopted. They have a rolodex on inhabitants for the behavior trainers and video cameras studying the animals to find out what makes them tick. There's the old friends section for senior dogs who need a quieter lifestyle, many of whom have outlived their owners, and you can bring your leashed dog to the public meditation labyrinth. The fitness center provides coconut oil massages and houses a hydro treadmill for dogs and cats for physical therapy and weight loss that fills up from the bottom. It's not unusual to see a cat in a life jacket.

Anything that comes in from the wild gets fixed and released. Sometimes they are adoptable, others live out their lives at the sanctuary like the four-year-old bald python named Boba. Some of the abandoned have been bred as pets and have never been outside. The parrot garden houses everything from parakeets to large macaws. There's an outdoor aviary. Rabbits get walked in strollers.

The local wild animals that call the property home are large birds like raptors, hawks, condors, golden and bald eagles. The number one cause of death for the big birds is lead poisoning that originates from hunting. There's lead in the bullets, which explode upon impact and go into

the animal's organs. Hunters usually gut the game on the spot, leaving the organs behind, which in turn the birds feed on, ingesting the lead.

There are several memorial gardens, and the one near the bottom is full. All current placements and burials are on top of the hill at Angel's Overlook. When an animal passes, it's full body placement, including the horses. There's no crematorium on the property. A blessing is done every month, like a shaman from the local Paiute nation who did the blessing in his native language. Angel's Overlook is on top and goes on for miles, with a display of trinkets and lights and statues left behind by loved ones. For a small donation, anyone from the public can place their animals there as well. Gratitude Garden is in honor of large donations made towards No Kill 2025, which includes names like Jennifer Aniston, Justin Theroux, and the Walton (Walmart) family. Four staff members' sole job is to take care of the cemeteries.

Founded by 10 dedicated animal activists including Francis Battista, considered to be one of the foremost thought leaders in animal welfare, his wife Silva, and son Judah, the sanctuary in Utah offers free entrance and tours to the public. There are also plenty of non-animal activities. Take a hike to Turtle Rock, explore the ancient Anasazi cave dwellings and petroglyphs, or just take in a plant-based meal at the cafe that overlooks the canyon. Cottages are available for rental and animal volunteer opportunities abound.

UNBINGED: WATCHING THE DETECTIVES - REVIEWS OF "BAD MONKEY," "BATMAN: CAPED CRUSADER," & "A GOOD GIRL'S GUIDE TO MURDER"

Evildoers beware. A brand new wave of sleuths has set forth to solve the onslaught of fictional crimes that flooded streaming services as of late. From teen investigators looking for extra credit to classic comic characters in new adventures, these self-appointed detectives are part of a new wave of vigilante do-gooders looking

to make streaming a safer place to wander. But are they worth watching?

Bad Monkey (AppleTV+)

Mostly known for its tourist-filled beaches, intrusive gator population, mugshots of colorful locals, and large assortment of family-friendly theme parks, Florida is also a veritable hotbed for

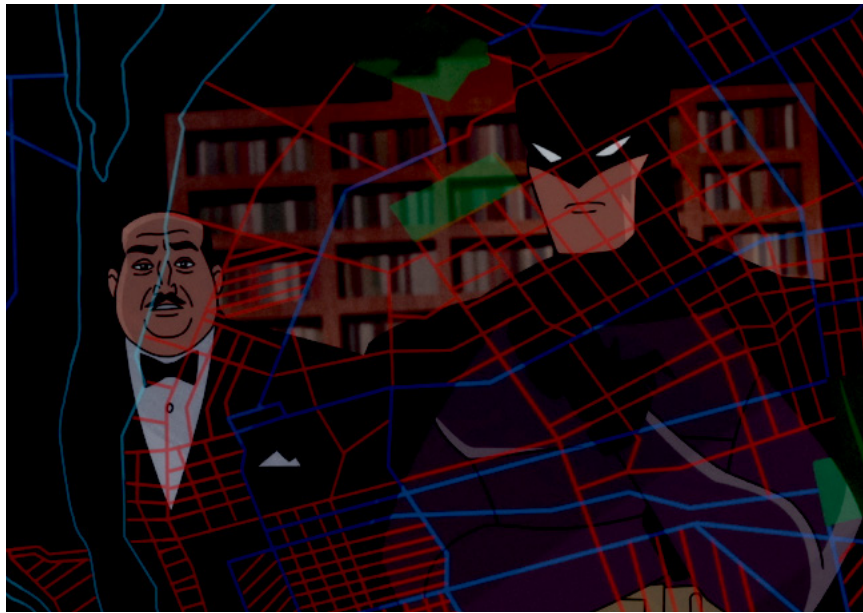
seedy criminal activity, at least according to primetime and cable. In the '80s, the Sunshine State boasted popular fictional and fashionable vice squads while more modern series offered vigilante serial killers and forensics shows. And now Apple TV+'s new dark comedy offers its take on Florida and those who dwell there. Based on Carl Hiaasen's cult favorite tome, *Bad*

Monkey spotlights greed, corruption and a mystery of missing limbs.

Vince Vaughn steps into the (gum) shoes of curmudgeon Andrew Yancy, a former homicide detective forced to work as a health inspector in the Keys, but hasn't quite embraced his new role as he still investigates a previous case. After a severed arm is fished out of the harbor, Yancy's fate becomes a chain reaction of events, one more ludicrous than the next, as each oddball character in his life steps up to the plate for a moment to shine in a bizarre mystery surrounding the detached arm, which may or may not involve a homicide.

Among the kooks who occupy a spot on Yancy's short list of possible suspects are Eve Stripling (Meredith Hagner), the arm's widow who isn't too bent out of shape about the overall condition of her deceased husband Nick, and Caitlin (Charlotte Lawrence), Nick's daughter who despises both her father and his choice in wives. Mix in his kinda-sorta girlfriend with a hidden backstory (Michelle Monaghan), a sarcastic coroner (Natalie Martinez), a vexed Bahamian local (Ronald Peet) displaced by Eve and her new beau, a real estate bro with no moral compass (Alex Moffat), a voodoo queen (Jodie Turner-Smith), and the titular bad monkey, and the series offers a veritable crockpot of oddballs, eccentrics and outsiders to keep audiences on their toes.

Though the mystery of the arm quickly unravels with few surprises, the curious collection of deviants who populate this little corner of Florida, as well as Vaughn's trademark snark — a skill he's been perfecting since his *Swingers* days — is what makes the series so engrossing. The result is an easy-breezy, well-written jaunt filled with enough WTF moments to hold the attention of even the most persnickety

viewer. *Bad Monkey* emphasizes Vaughn's comedy chops and what he can do with fun material as the series places him firmly back to leading man status.

Batman: Caped Crusader (Prime Video)

Before he became the scowl with a growl in a cowl on the prowl for Gotham's foul, Batman was a vigilante crime fighter who was viewed as a menace to both law enforcement and lawbreakers. The terror of the night, Batman was an enigma before Gotham City Police Commissioner Jim Gordon learned to trust him as the "World's Greatest Detective." And in *Batman: Caped Crusader*, the Dark Knight gets a cultural reset to the golden age as the animated period piece embraces its noir roots to give the bat a proper playground.

Executive produced by titans of geekdom Bruce Timm, J.J. Abrams and Matt Reeves, *Caped Crusader* continues the long tradition of allowing the toon versions of the *Dark Knight* to out-gloom his live-action counterparts. Boasting a retro look that harkens back to Bob Kane's original aesthetic from the Detective Comics era and *Max Fleischer's Superman* series from the '40s, *Caped Crusader* attempts to follow in the large footprints of the much beloved *Batman: The Animated Series* by giving audiences that they want: A brooding Bat with a lively Rogues Gallery, but with a few new twists to keep things intriguing.

Overhauling classic characters gives the series the ability to explore and create new aspects of their personality and lore. Barbara Gordon is reborn as a headstrong defense attorney while Dr. Harleen Quinzel has kept her medical degree and uses it to her crooked advantage. Oswald Cobblepot is now a maniacal

mama and mob boss, and attorney Harvey Dent is, well, still an ass. Some things never change.

Hamish Linklater is the latest voice actor to slip on the cape, bringing a proper amount of gravitas to both the *Caped Crusader* and the man whose millions fund his nighttime proclivities, Bruce Wayne. But the show spares no expense with the rest of the spirited voice cast, including Christina Ricci as Selina Kyle, Diedrich Bader as Dent and Minnie Driver as the Penguin.

Caped Crusader digs deep into the shadows of Batman's history to create fastidiously crafted, slightly macabre stories that both lean into its heritage while retconning the mythology. And while not every episode is a grand slam — there are a few misses here and there — the core stories should appeal to longtime fans looking for new Batman adventures.

A Good Girl's Guide to Murder (Netflix)

Five years ago, the small village of Little Kilton, Buckinghamshire, was rocked to its core by the murder of Andie Bell (India Lillie Davies), a popular high school student who was killed by her boyfriend Sal (Rahul Pattni), who then took his own life due to the guilt. But thanks to a meddling kid with an ambitious school project, Andie's case isn't quite as open and shut as it once was.

Welcome to *A Good Girl's Guide to Murder*, based on the book series by Holly Jackson. The "Good Girl" in question is 17-year-old Pippa "Pip" Fitz-Amobi (Emma Myers), a true crime enthusiast with a soft spot for Andie's ex, and thus a reason to prove him innocent. Pip means to solve Andie's case and find her true killer, regardless of the fact that few others want her to investigate.

A Good Girl's Guide to Murder combines teen drama with crime procedurals to create a riveting series made endearing by solid performances from its young cast. Though not the most complex character to ever emerge in the PG-13 gumshoe space, Pip is definitely charming. Compelled to always tell the truth no matter what and curious to the point of self-peril, Pip makes an admirable Nancy Drew 2.0 for the Gen Z sect. Part Encyclopedia Brown, part modern-day Velma without the horrific revision from Kelly Kapoor, Myers carries the series and manages to stay amiable despite her constant prying.

The mystery series is perfect for tweens,

teens and the young at heart who love a good PG-13 whodunit, but a bit juvenile for those looking to feed their need for the usual foreboding murder show. Myers and her cohorts share an authentic chemistry while she pesters her way through Andie's former friend group to find the answers she requires, making them equally annoyed and angry, and perhaps even dangerous. The series is overall a bit too sugary-sweet to truly scratch the itch for any true crime junkie looking for a fix. But for fans of teen dramas who like their saccharine entertainment with a hint of darkness, *A Good Girl's Guide to Murder* can satisfy that sweet tooth. **👍**

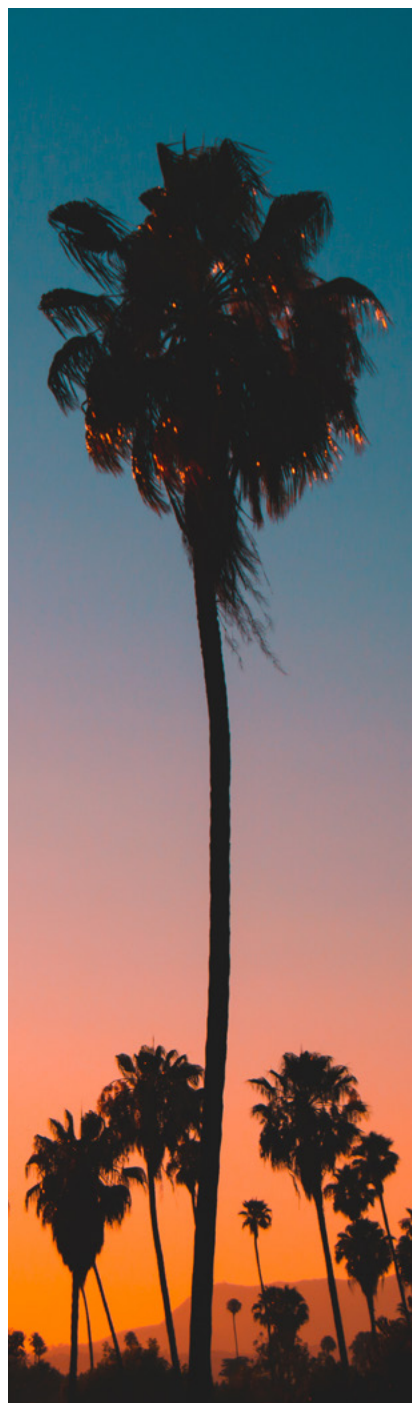
